**Course titles should match the listed titles*

- *No more than 12 credits of the same prefix can count toward the HSP certificate*
- *No more than 6 credits for each category can count toward the HSP certificate:*
 - *Internship*
 - *Capstone*
 - *Field experiences*
 - *Independent study*

Meaning, a student could get 6 credits in internship AND 6 credits in field experiences
