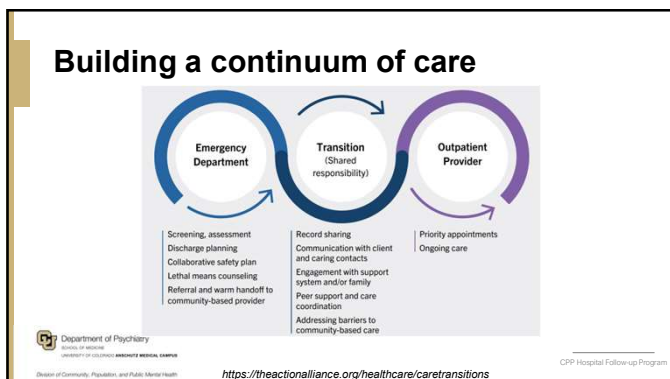
Healthcare providers can prevent suicide

- Hospitals are critical points for ensuring equitable and high-quality behavioral healthcare.
- 44% of suicide decedents have an ED visit in the year before death. *Aherndani 2019 (pmid 31400374)*
- Safety planning and follow-up care is as effective at reducing self-harm as the flu vaccine is at preventing flu. *Miller 2017 (28456130)*

- Most patients receive a call within 2 days and at least weekly follow-up contacts for 30 days

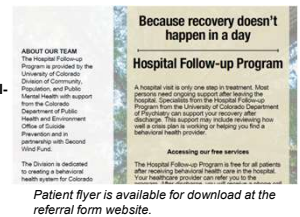

Monthly data reporting

Data elements are the same as previous.

Some data are required or defined by funders.

Some data help us understand how to improve and who we are treating.

We understand sites will have variation in defining cases.

How to report

- Report monthly aggregate data by the 10th for each site for the prior month.
Eg. an emergency department and inpatient site may be different; different EDs within a system each represent different sites

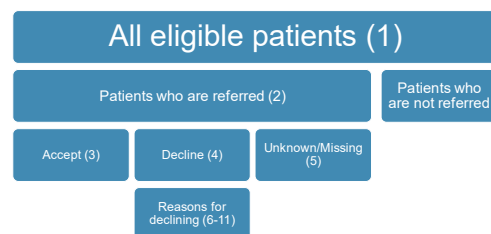
